Best-selling author J.A. Jance to speak, sign new novel at Nanini, Joyner-Green Valley branch libraries

Best-selling author J.A. Jance will discuss her latest novel, "Left for Dead," with book signings to follow at two Pima County Public Library branches in February.

Jance will talk at:

- 2 p.m. and again at 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 7, at the Joyner-Green Valley Branch Library, 601 N. La Canada Drive.
- Noon on Wednesday, Feb. 8, at Nanini Branch Library, 7300 N. Shannon Road.

Copies of "Left for Dead" will be available for sale and signing at both branch libraries.

With more than 21 million books in print, J.A. Jance is the best-selling suspense author of the Ali Reynolds series, the J.P. Beaumont series, the Joanna Brady series, and four interrelated Southwestern thrillers featuring the Walker family. Born in South Dakota and brought up in Bisbee, Jance lives with her husband in Seattle, Wash., and Tucson.



"Left for Dead" takes series protagonist Ali Reynolds to the Arizona border, which is plagued by illegal immigrant crossings and escalating drug wars that claim countless victims. Sister Anselm, who first appeared in Jance's 2009 "Trial by Fire," is a patient advocate on behalf of a young, seriously injured "Jane Doe" border crosser.
