Nanini Branch Library to close briefly for renovation

The Nanini Branch Library will close temporarily to allow completion of important renovation work such as computer replacement and expanding the children's area.

This library, located at 7300 N. Shannon Road, will be **closed between Saturday, May 9 and Monday, May 18**. The location will reopen for regular business hours on Tuesday, May 19.

Library customers should take note that checked out materials cannot be returned to the Nanini Branch Library during the closure, but should be returned to neighboring branch libraries during that time. In addition, reserved books will not be available for pickup until the library reopens.

The renovation also includes moving all customer services – information, reference and checkout – into one location rather than several separate areas. This “one desk” organization has proven efficient in other branches of the Pima County Public Library system. Renovations also will lead to more display space for library materials and expansion of the children's' area. A large educational structure, designed to assist in teaching children shapes, color and motor skills also will be included in the area.

This project has been in planning for two years.
