Joyner-Green Valley Branch Library to reopen after heating/cooling system replacement

A well-earned HVAC system replacement project will be completed, and the Joyner-Green Valley Branch Library will reopen for full service on Monday, Sept. 27.

Pima County Public Library officials expect the library at 601 N. La Cañada Drive to reopen to its regular schedule:

- Mondays through Thursdays, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Fridays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Sundays, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Much of the branch location had been closed to the public and the remainder was open only limited hours since the heating and cooling system replacement began August 9. Reopening was to occur on Sept. 17, but various construction delays extended the project.

In addition to a new environmental system, the branch library also was reroofed and interior lighting was replaced.

The entire project, paid for out of Library operating funds, cost approximately \$400,000. The project was planned for completion in 2010 as part of the Library's ongoing maintenance program.
