Pima County Public Library is holding an illustration contest for a book on water harvesting

Pima County Public Library is holding a drawing contest to collect illustrations for a picture book about water harvesting.

The book will be published by The Glassman Foundation, and is being written by Tucson City Councilman Rodney Glassman and Sasha Borsand.

Several drawings depicting the adventures of Jeremy Jackrabbit will be selected for the book. The drawings will be selected from among several age groups.

Young artists up to 17 years old can participate. Those interested in illustrating should look online at the Library's website, www.library.pima.gov, to see which book text applies to their age group. Each drawing submitted needs to follow that particular text.

Participants also must turn in an Entry Form and a Release Form with each entry. Those forms also are available online.

Each artist may enter **two** drawing samples based on the story of Jeremy Jackrabbit.

Illustrations can be of any medium: pencil, crayons, markers, etc., but no entry should be larger than 11" x 17". Entries may be in color or black and white.

Entries must be received by Friday, October 30, 2009 at 5 pm.
