### **Library downloadable books now work with Kindle Readers**

For many library customers, using their Kindles to “borrow” books may be a dream come true.

Pima County Public Library is happy to announce that customers with Kindle readers now can use the Library’s Overdrive Digital Books system. Although the Library has offered digital books since July 2005, incompatibilities between Overdrive and the Kindle reader prevented some customers from being able to download books.

Kindle using customers can browse and borrow from the approximately 4,000 books in the Library’s Digital Collection and new books are added frequently.

Here’s a primer on how Kindle users can use the Library:

- Customers will need a library card number and PIN.
- Checkout period: you choose 7, 14 or 21 days.
- Customers can check out up to five items at a time.
- Digital books can not be renewed.

Owners of many other e-book or downloadable audio devices may be able to check out books through the Library, including: Windows® computer; Mac® computer; Android™; BlackBerry®; iPhone® / iPad® / iPod touch®; Windows® Phone 7; Sony® Reader; NOOK™ / NOOKcolor™; Kobo™ eReader; and others.
