## LEGAL FORMS

If you do not understand something, have trouble filling out any of the forms or are not sure these forms and instructions apply to your situation, see an attorney for help.

Before filing documents with the court, you should consult an attorney to help guard against undesired and unexpected consequences.

Not all forms may be accepted in all Arizona courts – you should contact the court in which you will be filing to confirm the use of a particular form, determine whether any additional forms are required and verify the filing fees.

### **Pima County Superior Court Self Service Center**

The Center is located in the Pima County Superior Court building, 110 W. Congress, at the northwest corner of Church and Congress.
