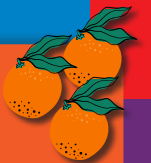
CVC Patterns

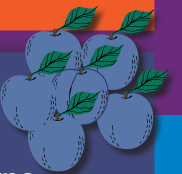
Vowel Patterns
